

Club Meeting Assessment

Goal of Lesson: To help club leaders conduct a self-assessment of their club and

determine ways to improve.

Objectives: Participants will:

Recognize attributes of a positive club environment

• Identify strategies for improving club environment

Do the Activity

1. Give each participant three half sheets of paper and a marker.

- 2. Ask the group, "Assume the role of a parent visiting your club meeting for the first time. Write three words (one per sheet) describing the meeting."
- 3. Collect responses and post.

Share

Describe what you saw at your meeting looking at it from a different person's perspective.

Process

With the group, separate the words into positive and negative columns. Review the descriptions.

Generalize

As a group, think of ways they could improve their club meetings.

Apply

Who has influence over the club meetings?

Rewrite the descriptions to how you'd like it to be in the future.

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
