

2023 Dress Code for Discovery Days

Taken from National 4-H documentation

General Guidelines All clothing shall be neat, clean, acceptable in repair and appearance, and shall be worn within the bounds of decency and good taste as appropriate for 4-H events. Prohibited items include excessively tight clothing, bare feet, hats, and caps (indoors), clothing that expose bare midriffs, undergarments, or that are transparent (see-through), articles of clothing that display profanity, products or slogans that promote tobacco, alcohol, drugs, sex or in any other way suggestive or distracting. A delegation adult chaperone and/ or the National 4-H Conference leadership team may ask any individual to modify their clothing selection if standards of decency in appearance are not met.

Casual - Most of the time youth are at Discovery Days, this will be the attire level.

Appropriate - Jeans, Khakis, shorts, or skirts that are at least mid-thigh length, t-shirts, tennis shoes.

Not appropriate – Pajamas, jeans or pants that are cutoff and/or worn with holes. Shoes with holes.

Business Casual - On Thursday night of Discovery Days, all youth will attend the Emerald Circle Event. This is the appropriate attire level for this event.

<u>Appropriate</u> - Slacks, skirts, button downs or polo shirts without ties, dress/ career shoes, boots.

Not appropriate - Athletic clothing or leggings, tennis shoes or flip flops.
