All shooters must be enrolled and have completed instruction in a Certified Kansas 4-H Shooting Sports program for the disciplines in which they enter. State qualifying rules will be observed in each of the disciplines. Check the State 4-H Shooting Sports website for all qualifying rules.

Entry forms are due by 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 8th, 2026.

Late registration only accepted to fill relays. Fees are \$15 per shooter per discipline.

Registrations are accepted from one person per county. NO REFUNDS.

This will be a 4-H Kansas State Qualifier for Small Bore Rifle. Please refer to the state match rules for 2026. The minimum age to PARTICIPATE at the State Match is **12**. To qualify for the State Match, the minimum individual score is 175 out of 300 possible.

A/51 Targets: Shoot 3X10 course of fire at 50 yards to include 10 shots in each:

🎯 Prone (1 minute per record shot)

🎯 Standing (2 minutes per record shot)

🎯 Kneeling (1.5 minutes per record shot)
